



Code of Conduct

You are reminded that the purpose of this Code is, to provide your child with an enjoyable and safe environment, where they are able to develop as a player, gaining personal fulfilment and satisfaction through friendly competition.

All Players should remember that if you become involved in illegal or any other poor behaviour you will be:

- Removed from the field or training session by the coach
- Sin Binned by the referee
- You will always lose the respect of many people

We ask Players to:

- Play for enjoyment and not just to please parents or coaches
- Be a good sport on and off the field
- Applaud all good play
- Never become involved in foul play
- Shake hands with and thank the opposition players and officials after the match, win, lose or draw
- Never argue with a Referee's decision
- Co-Operate with your coach, team-mates and officials at all times, without them you wouldn't have a game

All Parents should:

- Not force an unwilling youngster to participate
- Remember that young people are involved in sport for their enjoyment - NOT YOURS
- Encourage a disciplined approach to training and matches
- Remember that young people learn best from example, your child is a reflection of you, applaud good play by all
- Recognise the value and importance of volunteer coaches, referees and administrators, they give their time to provide opportunities for your children
- Remain off the playing field on match day.

We ask Parents to:

- Remain well clear of all training sessions, unless requested otherwise by a Team Coach
- Ask the coach if he needs some help, If you wish to assist with training sessions
